Touching Lives of Victims of Domestic Violence

Domestic Violence Shelters provide a temporary refuge for individual and family victims of domestic violence. Most of these shelters are run, funded and managed by volunteer and non-profit organizations or government agencies. Tough economic times have negatively impacted shelters. Alpha Kappa Alpha will provide some relief to domestic violence shelters in the local communities in which the 2012 regional conferences are held by donating toiletries, undergarments, and gift cards from pharmacies, drug stores and national department stores.



HOW CAN YOU HELP?

- Each registered soror is asked to bring toiletry items, new undergarments, or gift cards valued at \$5, \$10, \$15 or \$20 to the 2012 North Atlantic Regional Conference.*
- Toiletry items may include soap, lotion, deodorant, toothpaste, toothbrushes, dental floss, mouth wash, powder, hair products, nail polish and nail polish remover, nail clippers and nail files, razors, facial cleansers, make-up remover, cotton balls, Q-Tips, sanitary napkins, tampons, aspirin, infant/children/adult Tylenol/acetaminophen, and Motrin/ibuprofen.
- Gift cards should be purchased from *Stop & Shop* and *Shaw's* grocery stores, *Walgreen's*, *CVS*, *Rite Aid*, *Target*, *Walmart*, and telephone carriers and major gas companies.
- Donations will be accepted near the registration area at the Rhode Island Convention Center during conference registration hours starting on Wednesday, April 18th and ending on Friday, April 20th at 12noon.
- Your donations will be sorted, counted, and given to our local domestic violence shelter partners (*Sojourner House* and the *Women's Center of Rhode Island*) immediately following the Friday plenary session.
- Know that you made a difference in the life of someone with your donations.

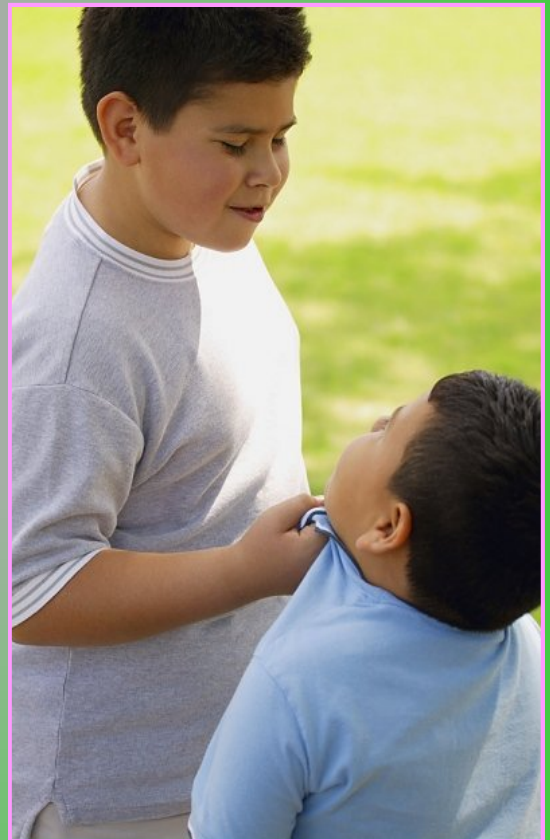
